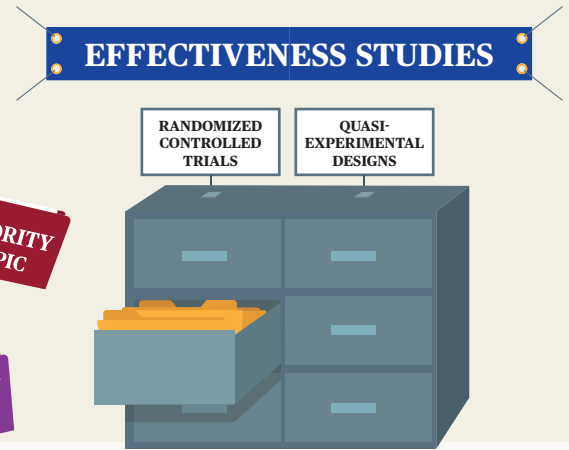
## WHY
