

## REL Resource Corner: Supporting Students' Access and Engagement Post-Pandemic

<u>Learn about REL Appalachia and its work</u>, and dive into these resources from across the REL program that support educators in ensuring student access to technology and other supports, as well as strengthening student engagement post-pandemic.

- Strategies to Support Learning Along a Continuum of Internet Access. This REL Central infographic helps educators develop and refine a remote learning plan by presenting a matrix of strategies for infrastructure, instructional supports, student supports, and parent/guardian supports necessary for various learning modalities.
- Research-Based Strategies for Effective Remote Learning. REL Appalachia produced a three-part series of train-the-trainer workshops that includes strategies to support students' behavioral, emotional, and mental engagement; ways to administer formative assessments to effectively monitor student progress and provide feedback; and approaches to design instruction for the hybrid model. Also check out the related infographic Leveraging Technology to Provide Feedback on Student Work, which highlights characteristics of effective feedback and strategies to provide it to students.
- When Students and Teachers are Separated: Strategies from Research on Social Presence for Teaching at a Distance. This interactive infographic from REL Southeast provides an overview of the five elements in the "social presence" framework, applicable to in-person instruction or when students and teachers are separated in the context of online learning. Each element of the model aligns to key strategies for K–12 educators to implement for building student engagement and connection in virtual learning context.

  to create and promote safe and predictable environments, relationship building, and selfregulation to support students dealing with trauma.
