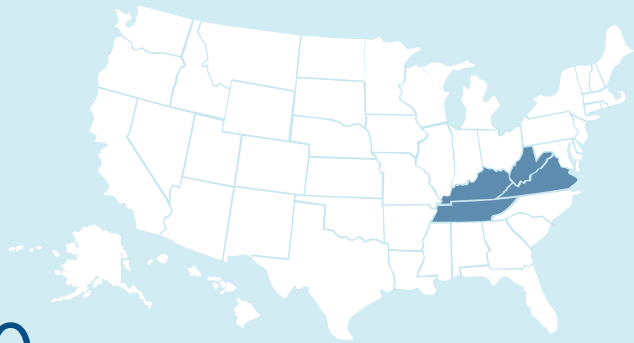


REL APPALACHIA: PUTTING RESEARCH INTO ACTION

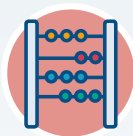
