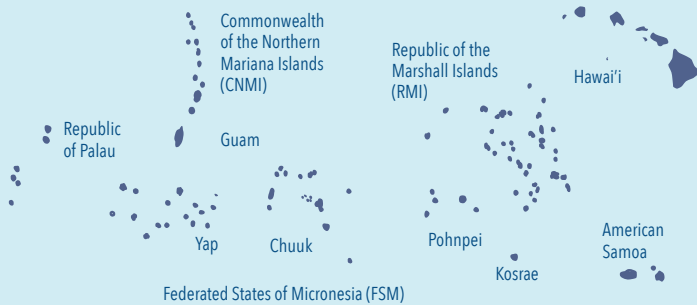


# REL PACIFIC: PUTTING RESEARCH INTO ACTION
