Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Specificity: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Title clearly describes the competency. - Micro-credential is narrowly focused on a discrete skill or competency. - Micro-credential can be stacked with others addressing related skills. • Importance: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Evidence-based - Standards-aligned - Relevant to authentic teaching contexts 	
Supports for learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accessible, high-quality, and comprehensive resources and supports • Mechanism to ask questions • Multiple types of job-embedded learning opportunities (if facilitated learning opportunities are provided)
