REL NW: How We Approach Our Work

In past years, Regional Educational Labs identified broad priorities for each five-year cycle and involved larger regional partnerships to understand educational challenges and promote the use of evidence-based practices. In the 2022-27 cycle, the RELs emphasize smaller, more focused partnerships with activities that will lead to measurable improvements in educational outcomes within the five-year contract.

The RELs conduct outreach and needs sensing with educators and policymakers, including state, local, and other education organizations, to identify specific needs and projects.

REL Northwest wants to provide research and support where it's needed the most, especially regarding equity issues that were magnified during the pandemic.
