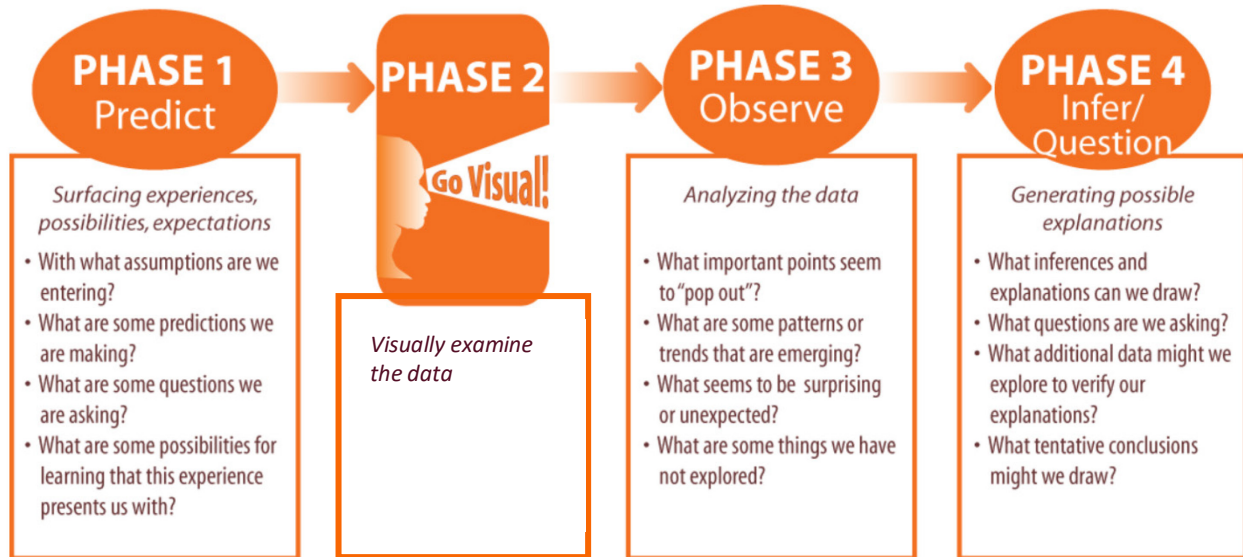


Handout 3 A: Data-Driven Dialogue Protocol (PDSA—Study)



Prompts	Answers
(5 min.) Phase 1: Predict. What do we expect to see in these data? What questions are we asking?	
(15 min.) Phase 2: Go visual. Read through the data. Make notes, highlight patterns, or create a data visual.	
(10 min.) Phase 3: Observe. What do we notice? What are some emerging patterns in the data?	
(10 min.) Phase 4: Infer/question. What inferences and explanations can we draw? What tentative hypotheses might we make? What new questions are we asking about student learning?
